Reflections of a Tenured Board Member


During my tenure as a board member, the Hancock County Community Foundation, Inc., became the Community Foundation of Hancock County, Inc. The name change reflects much more than a reordering of words.

During my nine years of service, the Community Foundation truly has evolved from an organization located in Hancock County to an organization that is nurturing community throughout the county. CFHC remains true to its mission of partnering with donors to create permanent legacies through planned giving – serving as a responsible fiduciary of, now, hundreds of funds that annually

award scholarships and grants consistent with donor intent.

Indeed, the growth of CFHC's endowed funds in these years has been remarkable. But several developments in these years have resulted in the Community Foundation becoming a much greater facilitator of increased community development. A few examples include bringing Imagination Library to the county (in partnership with the Hancock County Public Library), the development and launching of the Thrive Center (to enhance local government and community collaboration), and being tasked by the County Commissioners to guide the process for distribution of ARPA funds to local nonprofits.

It has been an exciting and rewarding time to serve as a board member. I look forward to seeing the continued growth in the Community Foundation's impact in the years to come. –Kevin Harvey

Preparing & Inspiring



The development of the new Talent Pathway of Hancock County was a substantial endeavor in 2022. Born from a community listening tour, the seven-module program's objective is to prepare and inspire community members to use their talents to elevate daily life, civic leadership, and business leadership across Hancock County by:

- Broadening and deepening the talent pool for civic engagement.
- Helping the public understand civic decision-making and how to engage.
- Providing a knowledge foundation for officials to perform their roles.
- Providing a knowledge foundation for business leaders and managers.
- Providing a knowledge foundation for nonprofit leaders and volunteers.

Talent Pathway participants may live, study, or work in Hancock County. They may hold any range of positions in their communities. They need not be the leaders of major institutions – in fact, it is best that they collectively represent a broad range of perspectives and roles. Their common interest should be to enhance the quality of life in their town or across our county.

Education Across the Ages

A proponent of educational attainment, the Community Foundation prioritizes the removal of access barriers at all life stages. It is appropriate then, that CFHC join fellow stakeholders in an endeavor to make the dream of a local career center a reality.

Since early 2022, momentum has grown to fill this resource gap in Hancock County with a facility dedicated to innovation and education for grades 9–12 and adults. Financial commitments have been made, building designs developed, programming identified, and partnerships with higher education solidified.

In the absence of current infrastructure, county superintendents have joined forces for the provision of trade and technical courses for high school students. Starting next fall, opportunities that students would otherwise leave Hancock County to acquire will be offered locally through this collaboration.

"Driving 45 minutes out of the county for pre-nursing credentials my senior year of high school was daunting," shares one student.
"Not only did it take me away from my home school and my friends, but my parents worried for my safety on a daily basis."

Success at Any Stage of Life

Hollie Kinker has been an active part of the Hancock County community since childhood when she volunteered at her church and was a 10-year member of the Hancock County 4–H Program. As a parent, she served on the PTO board for her children's elementary school. From 2020–2021 she served as a CASA (Court Appointed Special Advocate) for an eight-month-old. She and her children also volunteer at the Kenneth Butler Memorial Soup Kitchen.

She currently works in the Hancock County Auditor's Office where she has become aware that, "as my county grows, so does their need for increased resources in various areas such as environmental, social, and economic concerns." After securing her associate degree in general studies at lvy Tech, Hollie is now a student at I.U. East in Sustainability Studies, minoring in Environmental Science.

While parenting, working a full-time job, supporting the educational goals of her teenaged children, and taking 12 credit hours of college, Hollie has achieved a 4.0 GPA during her first year of study at I.U. East.

Hollie states, "I am humbled by the opportunity that the Community Foundation of Hancock County has given me to pursue my educational and career goals! Through their generous gift I was able to complete my associate degree at Ivy Tech and am now rounding into my senior year at Indiana University-East."

No Longer Hopeless

In 2021, Roshelle (Ro) Evans graduated as a Certified Medical Assistant. But before she could achieve this, she had to gain her sobriety with the help of the Talitha Koum Women's Recovery House.

After losing a loved one unexpectedly, Ro battled alcohol addiction for nearly a decade. "I was definitely hopeless," shares Ro. "I had no love for myself, no self–respect. I didn't think I was capable of doing anything productive."

Ro says she came to Talitha Koum not sure what to expect but knowing she wanted something better. She happily shares she'll be three years sober on Aug. 7 and feels like "the sky's the limit" for her. She has also become a Peer Recovery Coach so she can help others suffering from addiction to reclaim their lives.

Linda Ostewig, executive director of Talitha Koum, approached the Community Foundation with the concern that they were seeing many success stories like Ro's; however, when those ladies were ready to move on from the recovery house, they couldn't afford housing in Hancock County.

The Community Foundation made a \$5,000 grant to provide financial assistance for Talitha Koum graduates as they set out on their own. After months of searching, Ro was able to secure housing in Hancock County and begin her independent life, though never forgetting her time at Talitha Koum.

"I left knowing that no matter what, it didn't end there," states Ro. "I was always welcome to come back (to the Talitha Koum House). This will always be my home."

No Longer Homeless

Suzye Poley purchased a house and plot of land in New Palestine in 2021. As she was settling in, she made a startling discovery.

"I was very happy there with my small dogs for almost an hour," she recalls. "That was when I realized the place came equipped with 25 cats."

Over the next year, Suzye found homes for all but two of the cats. However, last spring those two cats produced 13 kittens.

"I tried to get the cats spayed or neutered, but at that time COVID was on everyone's mind, and the places that help weren't helping," she says. "Then I latched on to PAWS."

Partners for Animal Welfare Society (PAWS) is a nonprofit animal rescue in Hancock County that works to control domestic animal overpopulation through a low-cost spay/neuter program. In 2022, the Community Foundation granted PAWS \$8,065 to provide residents like Suzye with these services at an affordable price.

Suzye found homes for most of the cats, and she plans to keep the remaining cats, stating she is fond of them and they are great mousers. With PAWS' support, most of them are now fixed. She's still working to catch the last two. When she does, PAWS will be ready to help.

The Garriott Legacy

Despite not having children of their own, William and Barbara Garriott had a heart for young people and education. William, a veteran and retired real estate developer, was nearing the end of his life when he reached out to his attorney to rewrite his Last Will and Testament. Bill (92) and Barb (90) both passed away in 2022 and gifted part of their estate to establish the William L. and Barbara J. Garriott Memorial Scholarship that benefits students in both Hancock and Shelby counties.

Ron Polly was a dear friend of the Garriotts and shared with the Community Foundation kind sentiments about Bill and Barb. Ron states, "They were both very quiet, humble, and honest people. They didn't boast about what they had or what they did not have. Bill and Barb were very charitable and cared a lot about people."

During Bill's professional career, which he worked until the last year of his life, he developed Schildmeier Woods in New Palestine, Brandywine Trace in Morristown, a medical facility in Cumberland, and many other developments. Barb was Bill's right hand in the business handling the administration work and as the secretary and treasurer of their company. The Community Foundation of Hancock County is honored and humbled to steward this fund that will benefit students for years to come as the Garriott legacy lives on. 
