White Family Foundation Grant Cycle open

Applications open until May 16 at noon




The purpose of the White Family Foundation Fund, a fund of the Community Foundation of Hancock County, is to assist local community development and support initiatives that enhance the desire to live, work, and play in Hancock and Henry counties.

Eligible projects may include, but are not limited to beautification projects, building façade improvements, recreational enhancements and accessibility, public safety and transportation. Eligible applicants must serve Hancock and/or Henry counties.

The White Family Foundation Fund is a donor advised fund, which makes this grant cycle unique. A donor-advised fund is a charitable giving vehicle administered by a public charity (in this case, the Community Foundation) created to manage charitable donations on behalf of organizations, families, or individuals (in this case, the White Family). In this grant cycle, the White Family reviews applications, interviews applicants, and makes grant recommendations to the Community Foundation based on their charitable goals and interests. The donor also has the flexibility to extend their philanthropy beyond the amount originally allocated.

Program for new board members and those interested in board service

Does your organization have new board members who would like training on nonprofit governance and board service? Consider registering them for Mission Masters! Registration will open later this month.



In partnership with Indianapolis-area consulting agency [Hedges](#), the Community Foundation will offer Mission Masters, an exciting module of the [Talent Pathway](#). Participants will engage in virtual workshops as part of Hedges' [Lead With Purpose](#) curriculum, and they will meet in-person to network and apply learning to our local Hancock County context. Topics covered include effective staff and board roles, setting vision and strategy, fundraising, and activating committees.

The program will take place over the course of 4 months (August-November 2025). This program is a \$1,200 value, and it is offered by the Community Foundation at **no cost to your organization or the participant**.

Qualifications

- Participant must be either:
 - a board-approved, incoming member of your board of directors **OR** a currently-serving board member whose term will have been three (3) years or less as of 8/1/2025. We are looking for incoming or new members of your board. Your nonprofit must be located in or serve Hancock County.
OR
 - a community member interested in nonprofit board service who has not yet served on a board. Preference may be given to graduates of Leadership Hancock County or another module of the Talent Pathway. Must sign a statement of intent to join on a nonprofit board that serves Hancock County in 2025.
- Participant must be a Hancock County resident.
- Participant must provide a written statement of support from their employer stating they will be permitted to take the time to attend each virtual and in-person meeting (if applicable). We are looking for participants who can attend all sessions.
