To obtain a high school diploma in the state of Indiana, students must learn and demonstrate “employability skills.” A work-based learning experience, or internship, is one way to satisfy this graduation requirement. The Community Foundation is offering a grant program to fund paid internships for high school students at nonprofits. The goal is for this experience to not only provide a valuable learning opportunity for students, but also provide an expanded skillset and diverse perspective to nonprofits.



An internship is a form of structured and supervised experiential learning that provides interns practical experience in their chosen fields. Internships encompass learning objectives, observation, reflection, evaluation, and assessment. These will be paid experiences funded by the grant. This grant will cover internships during the 2025-26 school year.

The letter of interest (LOI) is open now and will close at noon on **Jan. 31, 2025**. The Community Foundation will select grantees in early February and connect grantees with the four public high schools to hire an intern.
